- Some of you may already have created a Time Capsule. Perhaps you could add some of our suggestions to it or maybe even create a second one – it's your choice!

STEP 1: SELECT A CONTAINER FOR YOUR TIME CAPSULE

- ✓ Have a look around your room/house and look for a container that you could store your memories in. It could be a cardboard box, wooden box, cereal box, plastic box, a bottle, a jar or any other container that will keep your memories safe. **(Remember to check with your parents that it is ok to use container.)**
- ✓ Today, or at some point over the week, decorate your chosen container. Make sure you put your name and the date on it. You could even add on the date you plan to open it again!

STEP 2: FILL THE TIME CAPSULE

- Every day this week we will share **some** ideas for you to include in your Time Capsule. You can select one, or more, to complete and put in. **(You do not have to do them all!)**

STEP 3: EXTRA SPECIAL INSERTS

- Your teacher(s) are working hard this week to create an extra special insert for your Time Capsule. Unfortunately we won't be able to give them to you this week but as soon as we are back to school, we will pass them on to pop in your Time Capsule.
- You could ask your Mum/Dad/Brother/Sister/Granny/Grandad etc to do something for you too. It could be a letter, a picture, their favourite photograph of you together. Anything they would like!

Wouldn't it be a great surprise to pop these items in an envelope and look at it for the first time when you open your Time Capsule in the future?

(It is up to you if you look at them now or save them for later!)

STEP 4: BURY OR HIDE YOUR TIME CAPSULE

- Once you have completed the activities from this week, your time capsule will be ready to be buried or hidden away until you are ready to open it again!
- It is a good idea to share with someone where you have put it – just in case you forget! Maybe ask your Mum/Dad where a good and safe place would be.

Create and decorate your Time Capsule.
